



Floristry 102 – Six Weeks

The Living Fresh Flower School is offering a six-week advanced floral design course for students who have completed our floristry 101 course.

Class size is limited to allow for a low student to teacher ratio. An intimate class setting such as this will encourage one-on-one instruction and faster results.

Students are to bring tool kits provided in Floristry 101. All the materials and supplies required for the course are included in the cost:

- Flowers, greenery, non-perishable design elements
- Containers and vases
- Floral foam
- Wire, ribbon, floral glue

Week One: Linear Design in Oasis

This class gives the student the opportunity to revisit the design skills learned in Floristry 101 by creating a one-sided, linear arrangement using floral foam.

Week Two: Foliage Design

This class focuses solely on the different types of foliage available in the floral industry and the many ways in which greenery can be manipulated, sculpted and altered to create cutting edge floral designs.

Week Three: Designing with Armatures and Non-Flower Elements

This class will further the skills learned in week two as well as introduce the use and creation of armatures alongside non-flower elements.

Week Four: Waterfall/Cascade Designs

Waterfalls and cascades are very specific design styles – you will be introduced to a new design concept focusing on creating floral arrangements that flow.

Week Five: Bridal Bouquets

Students will learn the basic skills required to design hand-tied bridal bouquets. Various techniques for finishing bouquets with ribbon will also be taught.

Week Six: Interpretive Design

As the final class in the 102 series, each student will be given a unique design concept to be executed during class. Students will not know the subject of their piece until class; each student will receive a different subject and must create a floral design interpreting said subject.
